


All exams are now held and proctored virtually – take your exam anywhere!

CONTINUING EDUCATION

The Continuing Education program promotes the importance of underwriting professionalism, maintains the value of the FALU designation, and recognizes continuing education for non-FALU underwriters.

To receive the ALU Continuing Education certification, report your CE activities through the ALU website.

Acceptable subject matter for earning CE credits include job-related technical, leadership and business specific content.

There is no cost to individual underwriters or their companies.

To receive the continuing education certification for 2021, complete 20 CE credits.

Two-year certification cycle starts in January 2022, with 50 CE credits needed over 2 years.

Successful completion of the full exam series together with a number of courses offered by the Academy's educational partners, leads a student to either the Fellow, Academy of Life Underwriting (FALU) designation or Medical Risk Assessment Professional (MRAP) designation.

FALU Diploma Program

This program contains a series of four ALU exams plus elective courses offered by the Academy's educational partners. These exams lead to the following ALU designations:

ALU Level One Certificate

Associate, Academy of Life Underwriting (AALU) Designation

Fellow, Academy of Life Underwriting (FALU) Designation

Medical Risk Assessment Professional (MRAP) Program

Designed for those insurance professionals who desire to learn about the medical aspect of underwriting, students can earn the certificate and after passing two examinations, the Medical Risk Assessment Professional designation. This designation is not meant to accompany the current FALU designation program, however a separate education program to enhance the student's medical risk assessment skills.
